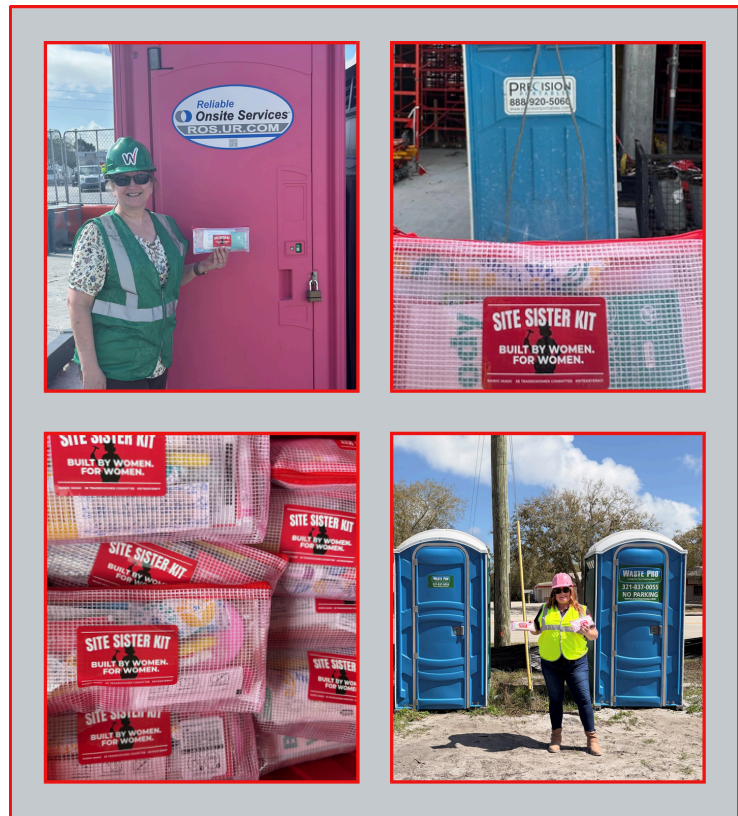
A MESSAGE FROM YOUR COMMITTEE CHAIR
